- **MIES** has a series of early childhood programs in different vulnerable sectors of **Ecuador**
- Evidence that points out the benefits of early childhood development
- Previous experiences improving early childhood development and learnings with continuous improvement and the collaborative model



The problem

A lot of efforts have taken place in Ecuador regarding Quality Assurance and Quality Control in early childhood development but very little attention has been destined to systematic and continuous quality improvement of processes in terms of efficiency an effectivity

Evaluation of the problem

Participants focused on improving early childhood development by focusing on lenguaje development since it's the lowest dimension in national scores.

Teams and projects:

- Developed a key
 Driver Diagram
- Tested change Ideas using rapid learning PDSA cycles
- Worked on a measurement strategy based on the common goal and the priority areas





Key concepts:

- User centered services
- Including the voice of users and families
- Psychology of change
- Creating community
- 5 habits of the heart



Measurement strategy

- Measurement in two levels
- An Improvement progress scale was used
- 8 out of 15 teams scored 3.0 (Modest improvement)
- Improvement in Integral Child Development scale used by centers





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Barriers

- Virtual communication
- Resources: time, budget
- Perception of more work



Facilitators:

- Team commitment and motivation
- Multidisciplinary and hands on approach



Conclusions

Local capability building in quality improvement is key to achieving better results. Developing improvement skills can contribute to better services that cam by systematized and replicated at a larger scale
